Communiqué

The Embassy of the Republic of Mauritius in Riyadh wishes to confirm that Mauritius is a plague-free country and no case of the plague disease has been detected on Mauritian territory.

Mauritian authorities are closely monitoring the outbreak of plague in Madagascar and its impact in the region. In addition, the Mauritian authorities have taken all the necessary precautions including a robust protocol at the port and airport for surveillance and prevention of plague entering the country.

The Embassy also wishes to point out that the World Health Organisation (WHO) has not recommended any travel or trade restrictions in the region, Mauritius in particular.

The Embassy wishes to reassure the general public that Mauritius remains a safe destination for travellers.
